would have been great to witness her dumping trash on the floor in front of the Supervisors to make the point that the county wasn't doing enough to keep Loudoun beautiful, hence the birth of KLB. Thank you, Agnes!

- **The KLB Board of Directors:** The dedication and sacrifice of current and former board members has kept KLB moving forward all these years in the face of growing environmental and funding challenges. How many organizations can say that they have board members that continue to contribute their time and energy for decades, even from Day 1? KLB proudly can.
- **The KLB Area Leaders:** Without this group of caring self-starters, Loudoun wouldn't be so beautiful, period. Some of our Area Leaders have been faithfully keeping their areas clean for decades, and even though some now have physical limitations, they continue to tirelessly serve the Loudoun community. We desperately need more folks like these to step-up. It's imperative that younger generations get involved and take the baton to continue the race to keep ahead of our ever-growing litter challenge.
- **KLB Volunteers:** While the reward and self-satisfaction is immediate, let's face it - picking-up litter is anything but glamorous. In fact, it can be a very dirty, challenging job, yet our eco-warrior volunteers lend a hand year after year. This year alone, around 1,200 volunteers donated almost 4,000 hours and collected 947 bags of trash, 349 bags of recycling, 223 tires, and lots of bulky litter. That's around 3 tons of tires and 19 tons of everything else that's no longer polluting Loudoun and our waterways. Clearly, KLB certainly couldn't be this impactful

without our volunteer army determined to make a difference and I'm very grateful and proud of their hard work.

- **KLB Supporters:** Like any worthy cause, funding is a necessary component of success, so I'm grateful for those that donate their money or services that allows KLB to continue serving Loudoun as efficiently, effectively, and safely as possible. Even though our operating budget is very frugal (we don't have full-time staff, office space, or even a phone line), without funding, we would have to greatly curtail our environmental educational and beautification programs or worst-case, disband. Fortunately, due to the generosity of our small group of supporters, including you, that hasn't happened yet, but every year presents a new challenge to make ends meet. I'm also thankful for those who support us by helping us spread the word (by mouth, social networks, media channels, etc.) and help us combat litter and other environmentally-damaging behaviors by championing common-sense initiatives and leading by example, because at the end of the day, both careless and deliberate littering are directly related to ignorance and human behavior.

All of these special components add-up to a well-oiled grassroots machine that has been producing significant results for 45 years, which is something we all should be thankful for.

Since it didn't work out to hold a fundraising event this year, we're dedicating the entire month of December to raise much-needed funds to fuel our annual programs in 2018. We haven't asked for your

## **Green Tip – 'Tis the Season...To Give**

Since Black Friday is (or perhaps - *was*) traditionally the kickoff of the holiday season that's full of gift-giving, how about giving some green? I'm talking about two types of green here, the first being cash to KLB just by buying something from Amazon Smile. That's right, Amazon.com will donate 0.5% of eligible purchases to your favorite charity, Keep Loudoun Beautiful! Giving something reusable, like bottles, insulated mugs (great for hot or cold drinks), and bags, says that you care about your planet and want to make it easy for those you care about take care of our fragile environment. What's cool about giving this kind of green is that it isn't just the recipients that benefit. We all benefit when someone chooses to reuse instead of choosing the usual wasteful use-and-toss lifestyle as we all share our Earth. KLB gives-out practical reusable bags and reusable bottles at our events, not because we have so much
